Re: *Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Tariff Changes to Electric Service Schedule No. 32, Service from Renewable Energy Facilities, and Electric Service Schedule No. 34, Renewable Energy Purchases for Qualified Customers – 5,000 kW and Over; Docket No. 24-035-T07*

Dear Ms. Saba:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the June 13, 2024 filing ("Filing") submitted by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) proposing changes to P.S.C.U. No. 51 Tariff Sheet No. B; Electric Service Schedule No. 32, Service from Renewable Energy Facilities ("Schedule 32") Tariff Sheet Nos. 32.1 through 32.10; and Electric Service Schedule No. 34, Renewable Energy Purchases for Qualified Customers – 5,000 kW and Over ("Schedule 34"), Tariff Sheet Nos. 34.1 through 34.3 (together, "Tariff Revisions"). The Tariff Revisions change the language in Schedules 32 and 34 to align with the language in the Energy Resource Procurement Act (the "Act"), Title 54, Chapter 17, Part 8, by replacing the word "renewable" with the word "clean." In addition, the Tariff Revisions update a reference on Schedule 32, Sheet 32.4, from Utah Code Ann. § 54-17-601 to Utah Code Ann. § 54-17-801. RMP seeks an effective date of August 15, 2024.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on June 28, 2024 ("DPU Comments"). No other comments or reply comments were filed. DPU states that during the 2024 Utah Legislative Session, the language in Part 8 of the Act was revised to replace the word "renewable" with "clean" throughout. During its review, DPU discovered a minor discrepancy at the bottom of Sheet No. 32.9 referencing "Advice No. 24-035-T07" instead of "Docket No. 24-035-T07," recommending that RMP revise and refile a corrected tariff at its own discretion. states the Tariff Revisions are just, reasonable, and in the public interest, and recommends the PSC approve them, effective August 15, 2024.

Based on the PSC's review of the Filing, DPU's comments and recommendation, and there being no opposition, the PSC approves the Tariff Revisions, effective August 15, 2024. The PSC also directs RMP to submit a compliance filing, correcting the redline and clean versions of the Tariff, consistent with DPU's recommendation to change the reference from "Advice No." to "Docket No." on Sheet 32.9, by no later than August 5, 2024.
