C. Contract Structure:

1. Rocky Mountain Power shall, by contract with the owner of the RenewableClean Energy Facility, purchase electricity for resale to one or more Customers;
2. Rocky Mountain Power shall sell that electricity to the Customer or Customers under RenewableClean Energy Contracts with the same duration and pricing as the contract between Rocky Mountain Power and the owner of the RenewableClean Energy Facility; and
3. Rocky Mountain Power's contract with the owner of the RenewableClean Energy Facility shall provide that Rocky Mountain Power's obligation to purchase electricity under that contract ceases if the Customer defaults in its obligation to purchase and pay for the electricity under the contract with Rocky Mountain Power.
4. The right to any environmental attribute associated with a RenewableClean Energy Facility shall remain the property of the RenewableClean Energy Facility's owner, except to the extent that a contract to which the owner is a party provides otherwise.
5. The RenewableClean Energy Facility is responsible for all transmission interconnection and transmission integration costs.
 - a. RenewableClean Energy Facility must be interconnected to the Company.

 - a. Clean Energy Facility must be interconnected to the Company.

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
