To whom it may concern:

Enclosed you will find a “revised” copy of Dixie Power’s retail electric rates both redline and clean copy. These rates were automatically adjusted due to a wholesale power cost adjuster procedure that was put into place in 2012.

The 2023 average wholesale power cost measured in cents per kWh was \$.04241. The year 2022 average wholesale power cost measured in cents per kWh was \$.042748 with the difference being a decrease of \$.000338 year over year. To keep retail rates simple, we have determined that the Cooperative will not have any retail rate change unless the year over year rate difference is at least \$.0005 per kWh and any adjustment will be rounded to the nearest \$.0005 per kWh.

Beginning on the February member billings, and in connection with the wholesale power cost adjuster procedure, the retail energy rates will decrease by \$.0005 per kWh. For the Residential rate, that will take the energy charge to \$.0655 per kWh down from \$.066 per kWh. The Small Commercial energy rate will decrease from \$.057 per kWh to \$.0565 per kWh and the Large Commercial energy rate will decrease from \$.032 to \$.0315 per kWh. The irrigation second tier energy rate was decreased by \$.0005 per kWh. These rates will be in effect for the months of February through May and October through January 2025.

These rate tariffs also include a seasonal Wholesale Peak Season Cost Adjustment that went into effect in March of 2023. The rates for billing months June – September are subject to the imposition of any peak season purchased power adjustment either upward or downward which may be established and approved for billing from time to time under established procedures. These rates for 2024 include a Wholesale Peak Season Cost Adjustment of .00852 per kWh adjustment, which is a direct pass through adjustment from Dixie Power’s wholesale supplier, Deseret Power. For the months of June through September, the residential rate will be \$.07402 up from \$.066. Small Commercial, Large Commercial and the Irrigation rate will see the same energy rate increase for the months of June-September.
