The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Garkane Energy Cooperative, Inc.'s ("Garkane") May 2, 2025, filing of several proposed schedule changes in its Utah Tariffs, relating to Net Metering Residential COG33, Plant Investment Fees & Service Charge SC, Small Commercial Net Metering COG34 tariffs, and its new Large Commercial Net Metering COG35 and Distributed Energy Resource Standby Service COG37 tariffs ("Tariff Revisions"). Garkane states its Board of Directors approved the Tariff Revisions following a properly noticed public meeting on April 21, 2025.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on May 15, 2025. DPU notes that Garkane's request for an effective date of June 1, 2025, meets the 30-day notice requirement in Utah Code Ann. § 54-3-3. DPU states the Tariff Revisions include new safety standards for net metering, establish a large net metering tariff due to increased interest in large solar generation systems, create a standby service rate for customers with solar and battery backup, and offer an alternative service charge for those not wanting AMI or smart meters. DPU indicates that Garkane has complied with the requirements in Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-12(7) and Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D)(6) and recommends the PSC acknowledge the Tariff Revisions, effective June 1, 2025.
