Dear Mr. Brown,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Garkane Energy Cooperative, Inc.'s ("Garkane") December 31, 2025, filing regarding several proposed schedule changes to its Utah Tariffs ("Tariff Revisions"). The PSC has also reviewed Garkane's January 6, 2026, corrected redline tariff schedules. (together, the "Filing") Garkane states that its Board of Directors approved the Tariff Revisions following a properly noticed public meeting on December 15, 2025.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on January 14, 2026. DPU notes that Garkane's requested effective date of February 1, 2026, meets the 30-day notice requirement in Utah Code Ann. § 54-3-3. DPU indicates that the primary driver for the Tariff Revisions is a necessary rate increase to address the rising cost of goods and materials over the past few years. Finding that Garkane has complied with the requirements in Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-12(7) and Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D)(6), DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Tariff Revisions, effective February 1, 2026.
