The PSC will conduct a hearing on interim rates in this docket on **Friday, June 13, 2025, beginning at 10:00 a.m.** The hearing will be conducted via Google Meet at the following link: <u>meet.google.com/bkz-upno-gwr</u>. All parties must have their witnesses in attendance and prepared to testify. If, after reviewing DPU's Preliminary Report and any reply comments, any party believes the hearing should be conducted in person, as opposed to virtually, the party must file a motion on or before Friday, June 6, 2025.

The PSC requests that attorneys and witnesses make themselves available by both video and audio during the portions of the hearing in which they will be actively

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participating. Participants are free to deactivate video, and should always mute audio, when not actively participating.
