**Re:** **Docket No. 25-035-04**, Rocky Mountain Powers Results of Operations, (PacifiCorp's Results of Operations Report for the Utah jurisdiction) for the twelve months ended December 31, 2024.

## Recommendation (Request for Extension)

On April 28, 2025, Rocky Mountain Power ("Company") filed its 2024 Results of Operations for the twelve months of the year ended December 31, 2024. On April 28, 2025, the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") issued an action request for the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") to review for compliance and to make recommendations with a due date of May 28, 2025.

After initial review, the Division determined the review will require requests for additional information from the Company, reconciliation of various federal filings, and additional review procedures. In the past review, the Division found this additional work requires an additional two to three months. Therefore, the Division requests the Commission extend the due date of the Division's response to August 31, 2025.
