The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) 2024 Annual Report of the Subscriber Solar Program ("Program") for the January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024, period ("Report"), filed on April 16, 2025, in compliance with the October 21, 2015, Order Approving Amended Settlement Agreement and August 16, 2017, correspondence in Docket No. 15-035-61 ("Reporting Requirements"). The PSC also reviewed the May 19, 2025, comments submitted by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). No other comments were filed by the May 19, 2025 comment deadline, nor reply comments filed by the June 3, 2025, reply comments deadline.

DPU comments that the Program has performed better than planned and appears to be nearly fully subscribed for 2024. According to DPU, there does not appear to be any significant cost shift or obligation paid by non-participating customers through the energy balancing account as a result. DPU also reiterates that RMP's Program Cost Model should be updated annually to reflect current tax laws and stresses that all inputs in the model should match current conditions. Through its annual review of the Program, DPU recognizes that perfect production forecasting is impossible, making minor fluctuations in subscription levels likely in some years. DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report.
