The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) 2024 Annual Report of the Blue Sky Program ("Program") for the period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024 ("2024 Report") filed on April 17, 2025. The PSC also reviewed the May 21, 2025, comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). No other comments were received by the comment filing deadline, nor any reply comments received by the June 5, 2025, reply comments deadline.

DPU provides a summary of the Program, highlighting sales, Renewable Energy Credit (REC) needs, and financial performance. DPU notes a decreasing trend in uncommitted funds, partially attributed to a block change approval in February 2022. DPU comments that from the December 2024 ending liability balance, RMP reports \$2,680,134 of Blue Sky Project commitments that are under contract but not completed and \$144,583 of estimated RECs that will be paid in 2025. In addition, DPU states that the Utah 2023-24 year-over-year change in revenues is down 2.45 percent with an expense increase of 31.1 percent, respectively. Finally, DPU comments that the 2024 Report complies with the PSC Orders in Docket Nos. 00-035-T01¹ and

07-035-T13² (together, "Reporting Requirements"). Accordingly, DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge that the 2024 Report complies with the Reporting Requirements.

Based on the PSC's review of the 2024 Report, DPU's comments and recommendation, and there being no opposition, the PSC acknowledges that the 2024 Report complies with the Reporting Requirements.
