Dear Mr. Backlund,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the May 28, 2025 filing by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) of its Affiliated Interest Report for the Year Ended December 31, 2024 ("Report"). The Report contains a summary of the current subsidiaries and affiliates associated with PacifiCorp, including officers and directors in common, services received and provided, and certain financial information. RMP is required to file the Affiliated Interest Report annually consistent with the PSC's order in Docket No. 05-035-34.<sup>1</sup>

The PSC also reviewed the November 26, 2025 comments submitted by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU comments it believes that RMP provided DPU with appropriate affiliate transaction information and that active affiliated interest relationships exist between RMP and the reported entities. Based on its review of those affiliate transactions, DPU believes the affiliate transactions do not appear to be averse to the public interest nor that they are inappropriately priced. DPU adds that the 2024 financial activity between PacifiCorp and the listed affiliated entities generally resembles prior years' activity. Accordingly, DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge that the Report complies with Transaction Commitment 8.
