## Recommendation (Request for Extension)

On May 30, 2025, Rocky Mountain Power ("Company") filed its 2025 Wildland First Cost and Compliance Report for the twelve months of the year ended December 31, 2024. On May 30, 2025, the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") issued an action request for the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") to review for compliance and to make recommendations with a due date of June 30, 2025. On June 3, 2025, the Commission issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period noting that interested persons may submit comments by July 3, 2025, with reply comments due July 18, 2025.

After initial review, the Division determined the review will require requests for additional information from the Company, analysis, and review procedures. The division has consulted with the Office of Consumer Services and found that they would support an extension for an additional 90 days to allow for additional time to gather information and time to perform additional procedures. Therefore, the Division requests the Commission extend the comment due date to October 1, 2025.
