The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) 2024 Annual Cost of Service Study (COSS) model and supporting exhibits, filed on June 17, 2025 (the "Filing"), in accordance with the PSC's May 29, 2014, correspondence in Docket No. 14–999–01. The PSC also reviewed the July 11, 2025, comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU).

DPU states its review of the 2024 COSS consisted of comparing the 2024 COSS model with RMP's 2023 COSS model. DPU explains that the 2024 COSS model is materially the same in form as the 2023 COSS model, with updates reflecting the year-end operation results. DPU also noted a slight delay in the Filing and expects a timelier filing next year. DPU states it identified no issues that warrant PSC action and therefore recommends the PSC acknowledge the 2024 COSS.

Based on the PSC's review of the Filing and DPU's recommendations, the PSC acknowledges that the Filing complies with the PSC's reporting requirement.

¹ The PSC directed RMP to file the COSS in its May 29, 2014 miscellaneous correspondence in Docket No. 14-999-01, consistent with the annual filing requirement in a stipulation (item 17(f)) the PSC approved by order issued November 23, 1999, in Docket No. 98-2035-04, in which RMP agreed to file an annual COSS for the regulated operations of PacifiCorp.
