The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) 2025 Net Metering and Interconnection Report and associated attachments and workpapers ("Report") filed on August 13, 2025, pursuant to the PSC's Order in Docket No. 10-035-58, the reporting requirements contained in Utah Admin. Code R746-312-16, and the other requirements in subsequent relevant dockets. The PSC also reviewed the September 15, 2025, comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU).

DPU provided background information on the relevant rules, reporting requirements, and PSC orders in various dockets regarding net metering. DPU also summarized and analyzed the development and changes in customers and generation for Schedule Nos. 135, 136, and 137 in the Report, and found no outstanding issues. DPU concluded that RMP's filing complied with the PSC's reporting requirements and, therefore, recommended the PSC acknowledge the Report.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges that the Report complies with the PSC's orders, relevant rules, and the requirements in the related orders.
