Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-17-502(2)(e), Rocky Mountain Power (the “Company”) hereby advises the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) that at this time it does not reasonably anticipate that it will need to acquire or commence construction of any clean energy resources¹ during the remainder of 2025 or in 2026. The Company may pursue other renewable resource projects in 2025 if the opportunity arises and will provide the Commission with notice if required.


