ISSUED: September 11, 2026

On July 10, 2026, the Public Service Commission (PSC) issued its Third Order Granting Motion to Extend the Procedural Schedule, granting Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) motion to extend the schedule until September 9, 2026, to allow parties an opportunity to continue to engage in settlement discussions prior to filing a proposed stipulated amended schedule in these dockets. On September 9, 2026, RMP filed another Motion to Extend the Procedural Schedule ("Motion"), requesting the PSC extend the procedural schedule in these dockets until November 10, 2026, for these discussions to progress further. RMP represents in the Motion that it has contacted the other parties in these proceedings, and none opposes the extension.

There being no opposition and good cause otherwise appearing, the Motion is granted. The PSC asks the parties to file a stipulated schedule on or before **Tuesday, November 10, 2026**. If the parties cannot reach a consensus, the PSC asks RMP to notify the PSC and request it set the matter for a scheduling conference.
