### Richard Junius Carling

1937 - 2024

Richard Junius Carling, age 86, passed his final finish line on April 30th, 2024, passing away peacefully in Salt Lake City, Utah, surrounded by his beloved family. Born on December 6, 1937, in Salt Lake City, Utah, to Jacob and Beba O'Brien Carling, Richard was the eldest of three children. He grew up in St. Mary's Park area of Salt Lake City, where he graduated from East High School in 1956.

Two days after returning from a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Southern Australia, Richard met Diane Saxe during a skiing trip at Brighton Ski Resort. From that day forward, Richard and Diane were inseparable. In the summer of 1961, Richard and Diane were married in the Salt Lake Temple, marking the beginning of a union that would span over 62 years. His family was the central focus and most important part of his life. He loved spending time with his kids, grandkids, and great-grandkids. He actively participated in each of his kids' lives. He attended all school and extracurricular events, always first to offer congratulations on a job well done.

In 1967, Richard began his political career, following recruitment from local Republican Party leaders. He served in the Utah State Legislature for 23 years (1967-1990), including 7 years in the House of Representatives and 16 years in the Utah State Senate. Richard held profound respect and deep affection for the Utah Highway Patrol. To him, the Highway Patrol and the Troopers were family. He was a steadfast supporter, always eager to hear their stories and ensure their well-being. He loved spending time with them and cherished his time serving on the Honorary Advisory Board with them.

Post-legislature, he chaired the Commission of Criminal and Juvenile Justice for eight years and served as vice chairman of the ethics committee for the 2002 Winter Olympic Games. His dedication extended to 25 years on the Primary Children's Hospital Governing Board and advisory roles at the U of U College of Nursing. Richard was instrumental in founding the Honorary Colonels, supporting the Utah Highway Patrol for over 33 years. He also served the University of Utah Alumni Association and Ensworth Board with distinction.

At the age of 39, following a health scare on the floor of the Senate, Richard took up running, which soon turned into a passion for marathons. Over his lifetime, he completed more than 175 marathons, including 39 consecutive Boston Marathons and 45 marathons in the City of George. His personal best marathon time was 2:30:21 in 1992 at the St. George Marathon remains a highlight of his athletic career.

Richard's presence in City Creek Canyon transcended running. He became a legendary figure whose spirit and dedication left an unforgettable mark on the local running community. His uplifting presence, friendly demeanor, and genuine kindness endeared him to all who can run alongside him. He was an evangelist for running, successfully convincing many novice runners to register for and complete a marathon.

Richard was a dedicated member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. One of his favorite callings was serving as the chapter advisor for the Sigma Gamma Chi POGO Chapter at the University of Utah. Richard effortlessly integrated himself into the fraternity's dynamic as "one of the guys," earning him the admiration, respect, and affection of its members. Richard and Diane loved to travel and made friends wherever they went. They loved spending time in Hawaii, especially Maui, where he could be seen running "an easy house up Kaanapali" in the early hours of the morning.

Richard and Diane lived in the same house for over five decades. Richard was a family man and beloved figure in his neighborhood, known for his enthusiasm and charisma. He was often seen talking with neighbors while gardening with Diane in the evenings.

Richard is survived by his four children: Angie Meyers (Mike), Cindy Carling (Cody), Michael, Teresa Carling (Jones), and Douglas (Molly). He is also survived by his grandsons, his great-grandchildren, and his siblings: DewAnn Robinson (Clark, deceased) and Mike Carling (Sallie, deceased). Aunt Bernice, who passed in death by his wife, Diane Saxe Carling, and his parents, Jacob Junius Carling and Beba O'Brien Carling, also survive.

Sven Russel Swensen, M.D. was born on October 17, 1937, to Russel and Beulah (Strickler) Swensen in Provo, Utah. He was the oldest of four children. In his youth, he learned the value of hard work, education, and fun. He attended Brigham Young Elementary, B.Y. Junior High, graduated from B.Y. High School, and attended University. Sven was true blue.

As a young man, Sven was called to serve in the Swiss-Austrian Mission of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Despite having Swiss grandparents, he was assigned to serve in Austria, which he came to love with all of his heart. His mission experience changed his life, planted a testimony in his heart, and solidified his commitment to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. It also provided lifelong friendships including the Swiss-Austrian Missionary Firebird Group which has met together in love and friendship nearly every month for six decades (and counting).

After living a life of service, which he passed on through his example. He always gave to those in need and selflessly gave of himself. During his church service he faithfully served in a variety of capacities including as Bishop of the Monument Park 14th Ward. Like his father, he was a gifted teacher, and, after retirement, loved serving in the Salt Lake Temple.

After completing his medical degree at the University of Washington University School of Medicine and then completed a residency in general surgery at the University of Utah School of Medicine. For Sven, being a surgeon and a trauma doctor was, in essence, a sacred calling. Through great personal sacrifices, he gave the best decades of his life in helping those in need and in pain, regardless of who they were. They were forgotten doctors. Dr. Swensen was not one of them. He was known for his kind, bedside manner, steady hand, humor, and dedication for his patients. There will be many reading these words who were cared for by Dr. Swensen, whether as a patient at his beloved LDS Hospital or as a friend or neighbor needing assistance from a trauma doctor, who can attest to his warm spirit, gentleness, and the extra stretch always helped make it "look a little better." Sven is grateful that his family always extended to him.

In Washington D.C. during medical school, Sven met Gretel Foxley who almost instantly became the love of his life. Three years later, in September of 1962, they were married in Salt Lake Temple and together established a family based on the gospel, love, service, and having fun. Soon they welcomed five children into their home, who knew that their father loved and supported them.

In 1993, Sven was called to travel to Austria as mission president along with children. Through his service, Sven extended his love and service to his beloved missionaries and deepened his love for the people and Saints of Austria as well as Slovenia, Serbia, Croatia, and Albania, where he was also called to serve.

Sven loved his traditions including going to Newport Beach, getting donuts with his kids, and his favorite thing he treasured gathering his family on Christmas Eve to eat schnitzel and shrimp, read Luke 2, and sing Stille Nacht (Silent Night).
