PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE OF THE UTAH LARGE CUSTOMER GROUP

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-207 and Rule R746-1-108, the Utah Large Customer Group ("UTLCG") files this Petition for Leave to Intervene in the above-captioned docket. In support of this Petition, the UTLCG states the following:

- 1. The UTLCG is an unincorporated association of certain Rocky Mountain Power ("RMP" or the "Company") Schedule 9 customers in the State of Utah.
- 2. As among RMP's Schedule 9 customers, UTLCG members receive and pay for electric service from RMP.
- 3. On October 20, 2025, RMP filed its Application in the above-captioned docket, seeking (1) a waiver of the Solicitation Process in the Energy Resource Procurement Act ("ERPA") and (2) approval of its "significant energy resource decision" to receive power from US SFR Owner LLC's (a subsidiary of TerraPower) 345-megawatt KU1 nuclear commercial demonstration plant through a 40-year Power Purchase Agreement ("PPA").

4. All significant, new energy resource decisions, including RMP's proposed KU1

PPA, if approved, will have a direct and substantial impact on the electric rates UTLCG's members

pay for service, as well as the reliability and quality of the electric services UTLCG members

receive from RMP. Accordingly, UTLCG members' legal rights and interests will be substantially

affected by this proceeding.

5. The UTLCG has not fully determined the specific positions it will take, or the relief

it will seek in this proceeding. UTLCG seeks to intervene for the purpose of protecting its interests

and the interests of its members as they may appear, particularly on issues relevant to RMP's

largest electric customers.

6. The interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of this proceeding will

not be materially impaired by allowing UTLCG to intervene.

7. The intervention deadline in this proceeding is March 9, 2026 per the Presiding

Officer's Order dated November 6, 2025. The UTLCG's Petition is timely.
