Pursuant to Utah Code section 54-4a-1 and Utah Administrative Code R746-1, the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) files this motion requesting leave for Division witness, David Williams, to appear remotely at the hearing for this proceeding, which is scheduled for March 31, 2026 (“Motion”). The Division also requests expedited consideration of this Motion due to the upcoming hearing date and because the time for responding to this Motion will not expire prior to the scheduled hearing.

In this docket, Mr. Williams filed direct testimony on behalf of the Division. Only Rocky Mountain Power (“RMP”) witness Daniel MacNeil filed rebuttal testimony. The Division recognizes the Public Service Commission of Utah’s (“Commission”) preference for in-person

testimony and makes this request for the Commission to accommodate remote participation to allow Division employee Mr. Williams, who resides outside of Utah, to participate in the hearing through virtual means because it is significantly less costly and more efficient and convenient for this out-of-state witness.

The Division has communicated with counsel for the parties in this docket and is authorized to represent that RMP, the Office of Consumer Services, Nucor Steel-Utah, the Utah Association of Energy Users, Utah Clean Energy, the Utah Large Customer Group, and Western Resource Advocates do not object to Mr. Williams appearing remotely at the hearing. And because the hearing is scheduled for March 31, 2026, the Division requests expedited consideration of this Motion. If the Commission grants this Motion, the Division plans to submit to the Commission by March 30, 2026, a copy of the written summary that Mr. Williams will use in providing his direct testimony at the hearing, consistent with the Commission's condition for granting similar motions in other dockets.
