Re: Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Tariff Revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 300, Regulation Charges, Docket No. 25-035-T02

Dear Mr. Backlund:

The Public Service Commission of Utah ("PSC") reviewed the February 5, 2025 filing by Rocky Mountain Power ("RMP") proposing changes to Electric Service Schedule No. 300 ("Schedule 300"). The proposed change to Sheet No. 300.2 is:

1. Adjust the current carrying charge rate from 5.34% to 5.40%.

According to RMP, the proposed change reflects the updated carrying charge rate determined using "Aaa and Baa corporate bond yields as published by Moody's Analytics" as required in Docket No. 17-035-T02.² RMP requests an effective date of April 1, 2025.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities ("DPU") filed on February 18, 2025. No other comments were filed. DPU confirms that the proposed carrying charge is calculated correctly and states the "proposed carrying charge of 5.40 percent [is] just, reasonable, and in the public interest." Accordingly, DPU recommends the PSC approve RMP's revised Schedule 300 as filed, effective April 1, 2025.

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Based on the PSC's review of RMP's filing, the comments and recommendations from DPU, and there being no opposition, the proposed revision to Sheet No. 300.2 in RMP's Schedule 300 is approved, effective April 1, 2025. The PSC directs RMP to refile its proposed tariff sheets, both the redline and clean versions, to reflect an effective date of "April 1, 2025" under the Description heading, next to the Sheet No. referenced 9R.4, which currently reflects an effective date of "April 1, 2024."
