The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed the July 3, 2025, filing (“Filing”) submitted by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) proposing modifications to RMP’s Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 52 for the purpose of complying with the PSC’s Order Granting Partial Reconsideration issued June 26, 2025, in Docket No. 24-035-04.

The PSC has also reviewed the comments the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on July 9, 2025, relating to the Filing. DPU represents it reviewed the Filing and identified no issues with RMP’s proposed revisions. DPU recommends the PSC approve the Filing, including the proposed effective date of April 25, 2025. No other party filed comments in the docket.

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Based on the PSC's review of the Filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves the Filing, effective April 25, 2025, consistent with its prior order.
