Re: Docket No. 25-035-T12 – *Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Tariff Changes Related to its Time of Use Programs*

Dear Mr. Backlund:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed the October 15, 2025 filing ("Filing") submitted by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) proposing updates to RMP's Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 52 ("Tariff"). RMP proposes tariff changes to reflect the result of discussions held on July 30, 2025 and September 24, 2025 regarding marketing, education outreach, and pilot evaluation parameters ("Workshops") for the residential time of use (TOU) pilot program¹ ("Tariff Revisions"). RMP included with the Filing revised Tariff Sheet Nos. 1.2, 2.2, and 2E.2 under Residential Service ("Revised Schedule 1 and 2 Tariff Sheets"); revised Tariff Sheet Nos. 6A.2, and 6A.3, under General Service ("Revised Schedule 6 Tariff Sheets"); a revised Tariff Sheet No. 10.3 under Irrigation and Soil Drainage Pumping Power Service ("Revised Schedule 10 Tariff Sheet"); and revised Tariff Sheet Nos. 135.3,

¹ The 2024 General Rate Case ("GRC") Phase II Settlement Stipulation specified changes to RMP's residential time of use program and stated RMP would host workshops to discuss marketing, education outreach, and pilot evaluation parameters for the residential time of use pilot program. The workshops were held on July 30, 2025 and September 24, 2025. See *Application of Rocky Mountain Power for Authority to Increase its Retail Electric Utility Service Rates in Utah and for Approval of its Proposed Electric Service Schedules and Electric Service Regulations*, ("2024 GRC"), Docket No. 24-035-04, Phase II Settlement Stipulation (Jan. 14, 2025) (subsequently approved by the PSC on April 25, 2025).

135.4, 135.5, and 135.6, under Net Metering Service (“Revised Schedule 135 Tariff Sheets”).

Revised Schedule 1 and 2 Tariff Sheets: Adds the phrase “On or Around” to the December 1, 2025 Deadline. Under the terms of the cost-of-service stipulation in the 2024 GRC Phase II Settlement Stipulation, all residential TOU customers were to be moved into the newly-approved Schedule 1 TOU pilot program effective December 1, 2025.

Revised Schedule 6 Tariff Sheets: Updates the TOU periods the 2024 GRC approved and reflects pricing newly calculated using the hourly advanced metering infrastructure data, and removes language referencing time periods to account for Daylight Saving Time.

Revised Schedule 10 Tariff Sheet: Revises the on- and off-peak energy charges to account for updated billing determinants that properly account for the weekend off-peak period change from RMP’s initial filing.

Revised Schedule 135 Tariff Sheets: Adds language to clarify how billing will work for net metering customers who are also on a TOU schedule.

The PSC has also reviewed the comments the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on October 30, 2025. DPU represents that no stakeholders opposed the Schedule 1 tariff changes RMP presented during the Workshops. DPU states it is unopposed to the proposed Schedule 6 updates. DPU recommends the PSC approve the updated Schedule 10 TOU prices because they more accurately reflect the intent of the Phase II Stipulation and the PSC’s order in the 2024 GRC. Finally, DPU states that the Revised Schedule 135 Tariff Sheets address the stakeholders’ concerns raised during Workshops, should increase customer acceptance of RMP’s net metering program, and allow customers to better evaluate whether to participate in it; therefore, the PSC should approve the Revised Schedule 135 Tariff Sheets. Accordingly, DPU recommends the PSC approve all proposed tariff changes as filed because they are reasonable and in the public interest. No other party filed comments in this docket.

Based on the PSC’s review of the Filing and DPU’s comments and recommendation, and there being no opposition, the PSC approves the Revised Schedule 1 and 2, Schedule 6, Schedule 10, and Schedule 135 Tariff Sheets as filed.
