Re: *Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Tariff Update to Electric Service Schedule No. 2, Residential Service Optional Time of Day Rider Experimental*, Docket No. 25-035-T13

Dear Mr. Backlund:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed the December 19, 2025, filing ("Filing") submitted by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) proposing updates to RMP's Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 52 ("Tariff") Sheet No. 2.2 ("Tariff Revisions"). The Tariff Revisions change the language of Special Condition 4 to reflect the language from the 2024 General Rate Case Phase II Settlement Stipulation. RMP included with the Filing revised Tariff Sheet No. 2.2. Special Condition 4 now reads: "On or around December 1, 2025, Customers taking service on this Schedule shall transfer to the Time-of-Use Option listed on Schedule 1." RMP requests an effective date of December 1, 2025.

The PSC has also reviewed the comments the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on December 31, 2025. No other party filed comments in this docket. According to DPU, the current language contains unclear, misleading, or now obsolete text, which the Tariff Revisions should remedy. Accordingly, DPU recommends the PSC approve the Tariff Sheets.

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Based on the PSC's review of the Filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, and there being no opposition, the PSC approves the Tariff Revisions as filed.
