**Re:** **Docket No. 25-066-T01**, Dixie Power's Proposed Tariff Revisions.

In response to the Public Service Commission's (Commission) Action Request in Docket No. 25-066-T01, on February 5, 2025, the Division of Public Utilities (Division) filed its memorandum recommending the Commission acknowledge Dixie Escalante Rural Electric Association's (Dixie or Company) proposed changes to its tariff titled Electric Rates for Utah and make them available for public inspection. On February 12, 2025, the Commission issued its acknowledgment letter. On February 14, Dixie identified a discrepancy on page 1 of the Division's Action Request Response. Specifically, Dixie indicated the sentence "The irrigation rates will be in effect for the months of March through May and October through February 2026." should be deleted because the tariff change does not apply to irrigation rates.

The Division concurs with the Company. We are refiling the memo to address a minor discrepancy identified in the Action Request Response document regarding irrigation rates. Specifically, the sentence noted above has been removed. This revision ensures that the memo accurately reflects the terms of the agreement and eliminates any potential confusion. The Division does not change its recommendation that the Commission



acknowledge Dixie Escalante Rural Electric Association's changes to its tariff titled Electric Rates for Utah and make them available for public inspection.
