Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-207 and Rule R746-1-108, Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp (“Rocky Mountain Power” or the “Company”), files this Petition for Leave to Intervene in the above-captioned docket before the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”). In doing so, Rocky Mountain Power states the following:

1. On November 24, 2025, Will-Power UT, LLC (“Will-Power” or “Applicant”) filed with the Commission a Notice of Registration as a Large-Scale Generation Provider, pursuant to U.C.A. § 54-26-501, et seq. (“Large Load Act”), and R746-318, et seq., specifically R746-318-401.<sup>1</sup>

2. On March 24, 2026, Will-Power filed with the Commission a Large-Scale Generation Provider’s Application for a Closed Private Generation Contract (“Application”) in compliance with R746-318-201 and R746-318-601.

<sup>1</sup> At the time of Will-Power’s Notice of Registration, R746-318 was pending adoption in Docket No. 25-R318-01 (“Large Load Rules”). The Large Load Rules became effective January 1, 2026.

3. In the Application, Will-Power states it is seeking to provide service to a customer through a closed private generation system as a large-scale generation provider in the state of Utah.

4. Because the Application and relief sought by Will-Power could implicate Rocky Mountain Power's rights under Utah law and its certificated service territory, the Company has a direct and substantial interest in the Application in this docket and may be directly affected by the outcome of this docket.

5. PacifiCorp d/b/a Rocky Mountain Power, an Oregon corporation, provides electric service to retail customers as Rocky Mountain Power in the states of Wyoming, Utah, and Idaho, and as Pacific Power in the states of Oregon, California, and Washington.

6. Rocky Mountain Power is a public utility in the state of Utah and is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction with respect to its prices and terms of electric service to retail customers in Utah. The Company serves over 1 million customers in Utah. Rocky Mountain Power's principal place of business in Utah is 1407 West North Temple, Suite 310, Salt Lake City, Utah 84116

7. Rocky Mountain Power seeks to intervene to ensure that its interests are protected, to obtain information about the Application and Will-Power's proposed facilities, and to be able to represent to the Commission the Company's position on the relief sought in the Application and on broader legal and public policy issues that may be implicated in this matter.

8. The interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of this proceeding will not be impaired by the Rocky Mountain Power's intervention. Rocky Mountain Power has significant experience in front of the Commission and will comply with the schedule in this proceeding.


