Re: Docket No. 26-030-05 - *Moon Lake Electric Association's Wildland Fire Protection Plan*

Dear Mr. Miles,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Moon Lake Electric Association's (MLEA) July 8, 2026 filing of its Wildland Fire Protection Plan (WFPP). The WFPP provides an overview of MLEA and describes the range of activities that MLEA is taking or considering to mitigate wildfire threats. The WFPP includes MLEA's objectives, analysis, strategies and protocols, community outreach and education, as well as integration with applicable plans.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed on August 4, 2026 by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). The DPU summarizes seven implementation steps presented in the WFPP and states that MLEA's Board of Directors reviewed and approved the WFPP on June 24, 2026. Additionally, DPU notes the following items: the creation of a WFPP committee, updated fire risk modeling, and "county-level collaboration with various fire departments, jurisdictional assistance agencies, and state and federal agencies."¹ DPU also recommends that MLEA organize the planned mitigation activities and budgets by year and carry that organization forward into its yearly cost and compliance report. Finally, DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge that MLEA has complied with the filing requirements in Utah Code § 54-24-203(1-3).
