Re: Rate Adjustment for Outdoor Lighting

To Whom it May Concern,

During the Board of Directors' meeting held December 15, 2026 the Mt. Wheeler Power board of directors discussed and on January 21, 2026 the Mt. Wheeler Power board of directors approved for the first reading the rate schedule that is being submitted to your office for adjustment. The attached tariffs show an effective date of February 1, 2026, however we have extended this to March 1, 2026. This rate adjustment has become necessary as Mt. Wheeler Power, like all electric utilities, have experienced increasing cost pressures from material, labor, and regulatory requirements. In November of 2025 Mt. Wheeler engaged in a cost-of-service study which also supports these adjustments. We anticipate that the board will approve the rates for the second reading on February 10, 2026 and Mt. Wheeler will put the rates into effect March 1, 2026.

Mt. Wheeler Power is headquartered in Ely, Nevada and has complied by all reporting requirements in the state of Nevada.
