Dear Mr. Robison,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Mt. Wheeler Power, Inc.'s ("Mt. Wheeler" or "the Company") January 29 and February 11, 2026, filing (the "Filing") of proposed rate adjustments ("Tariff Revisions"). Mt. Wheeler indicates that the proposed Tariff Revisions are necessary as the Company has experienced increasing cost pressures from material, labor, and regulatory requirements. Mt. Wheeler also states that it has complied with all Nevada (its headquarters) reporting requirements. The Filing proposes an effective date of March 1, 2026.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on February 11, 2026. DPU indicates that Mt. Wheeler's Board of Directors had approved the Tariff Revisions in two readings with the Company. DPU notes that the Tariff Revisions include increases across various service categories such as outdoor lighting, street lighting, and miscellaneous charges. Despite the filing not strictly meeting the standard 30-day notice period, DPU found no significant harm caused by the delay. DPU confirmed that the Company provided the necessary updates and recommended that the PSC acknowledge the Tariff Revisions, effective March 1, 2026.

Based on the PSC's review of the Tariff Revisions and DPU's comments and recommendations and given that Mt. Wheeler has complied with all Nevada reporting requirements, the PSC finds good cause exists to acknowledge the Tariff Revisions. The PSC acknowledges the Tariff Revisions comply with Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-12 and makes them available for public inspection. The PSC directs the Company to file a replacement Attachment 1 reflecting an effective date of March 1, 2026.
