Recommendation (Request for Extension)

On February 13, 2026, the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") issued an Action Request to the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") for a review of PacifiCorp's Semi-Annual Hedging Report with a due date of March 16, 2026. The Division requests an extension of the Action Request due date to April 15, 2026.

Issue

The Semi-Annual Hedging report provides a summary of the hedging activities for both natural gas and electricity. The hedging program is very complex, and the Division is continuing to gain a better understanding of the hedging program and requests additional time to complete a more comprehensive analysis. The Division is still awaiting answers to data requests and is requesting an extension to thoroughly review and analyze the responses, while also considering the possibility of asking additional questions if needed.
