Dear Commissioners:

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-17-502(2)(e), Rocky Mountain Power (the “Company”) informs the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) that the Company expects the need to procure a clean energy resource under Utah’s Community Clean Energy Act at some point in 2026 or 2027, depending on the timing of program implementation. Beyond this resource, the Company does not reasonably anticipate that it will need to acquire or commence construction of any additional clean energy resources during the remainder of 2026 or in 2027. The Company may pursue other renewable resource projects in 2026 if the opportunity arises, and will provide the Commission with appropriate notice if required.

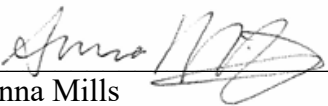
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
