The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's proposed tariff sheets filed on January 2, 2026 (the "Filing") in compliance with the mandates established in the PSC's Order Approving Settlement Stipulation dated December 29, 2025, under Docket No. 20-035-34 (the "Order").

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on January 7 and 8, 2026. DPU indicates that the Filing correctly incorporates provisions of the Order. Following an evaluation of the Filing, DPU concluded that the Filing fully complies with the approved settlement stipulation and faithfully translates the PSC's directives without deviations or non-compliant alterations. DPU recommends that the PSC approve the proposed tariff sheets with an effective date of January 1, 2026.

Based on the PSC's review of the Filing, the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC has determined that the Filing properly implements the approved settlement stipulation and complies with the requirements set forth in the Order. The PSC acknowledges the Filing as submitted, effective January 1, 2026.
