Enclosed for filing is an updated tariff sheet associated with Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 52 of PacifiCorp, d.b.a Rocky Mountain Power, applicable to electric service in the State of Utah. This tariff sheet is modified to reflect the updated carrying charge rate of 5.68%. Pursuant to the requirement of Rule R746-405-2(D), Rocky Mountain Power (the "Company") states that the proposed tariff sheet does not constitute a violation of state law or Commission rule. The Company respectfully requests an effective date of April 1, 2026, for the proposed tariff changes.




