Re: *Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Tariff Revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 300, Regulation Charges*; Docket No. 26-035-T04

Dear Mr. Backlund:

The Public Service Commission of Utah ("PSC") reviewed the February 25, 2026 filing by Rocky Mountain Power ("RMP") proposing changes to Electric Service Schedule No. 300 ("Schedule 300"). RMP proposes to revise Sheet No. 300.2 to adjust the current carrying charge rate from 5.40% to 5.68%.

According to RMP, the proposed change reflects the updated carrying charge rate determined using "Aaa and Baa corporate bond yields as published by Moody's Analytics"¹ as required in Docket No. 17-035-T02.² RMP requests an effective date of April 1, 2026.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on March 10, 2026. No other comments were filed, and no reply comments were filed on March 19, 2026. DPU confirms that the proposed carrying charge is calculated correctly and states the "proposed carrying charge of 5.68 percent [is] just, reasonable, and in the public interest."³ Accordingly, DPU recommends the PSC approve RMP's revised Schedule 300 as filed, effective April 1, 2026.
