Rocky Mountain Power Reply Comments


On April 27, 2026, the Utah Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) filed an Action Request Response in the above referenced docket, including a recommendation that the Public Service Commission of Utah approve Rocky Mountain Power’s (“Company”) application to change the rate for Electric Service Schedule 97.¹

The Division also included a recommendation to modify the rate effective date of the tariff from May 15, 2026 to May 22, 2026.² The Division argues that this change “arrives closest to zero” and “allows the Company to fully recover its authorized costs without placing any additional interest burden, though immaterial, on ratepayers by needlessly maintaining a balance.”³

The Company agrees with this recommendation, and includes with this filing both a red-lined copy and a clean copy of the tariff sheet for Electric Service Schedule 97 with the recommended changes to the rate effective date.


