Supplement to Large-Scale Generation Provider's Notice to Customer Under R746-318-402 and R746-318-601

Under R746-318-402 and R746-318-601, the Large Load Customer (the "Customer") to the Power Purchase Agreement (the "PPA") is entitled to certain specific notice. Will-Power UT, LLC ("Will-Power") has sent a letter providing the Customer the requisite notice. Will-Power will supplement with a subsequent filing informing the Public Service Commission upon Customer's confirmation of receipt of notice.

For the Commission's records, the notice provided to the Customer is reflected, herein.

I. Notice as required under R746-318-402.

1. If Will-Power, as the large-scale generation provider fails to comply with its legal requirements under Title 54, Chapter 26, Large-Scale Electric Service Requirements, the Commission may suspend or revoke the large-scale generation provider's registration and prohibit it from continuing to provide service after the large load customer is given reasonable opportunity to secure alternative service.

2. The Customer's load is subject to curtailment if the large load customer's demand exceeds the real-time dispatch of the large-scale generation provider's resources under the PPA, net of transmission losses.

3. Except as explicitly provided in the PPA, the qualified electric utility has no duty to serve the Customer which has entered into the PPA with Will-Power.

4. Except as explicitly provided in the PPA, the qualified electric utility is not required to provide backup power to the Customer which has entered into the PPA with Will-Power.

II. Notice as required under R746-318-601(2)(e).

5. The closed private generation system from which Customer will receive service is not connected to and operates independently from the transmission system of the qualified electric utility, cooperative utility, municipal utility, or any other utility.

6. The qualified electric utility has no duty to provide electric service including any ancillary services.

7. No backup power is available in the event of an outage.
8. Any request for interconnection to the qualified electric utility, for any level of service, requires the large load customer to submit a large-scale service request to the qualified electric utility and adhere to the process, cost allocations, and timelines set forth in Title 54, Chapter 26, Large-Scale Electric Service Requirements.
