Dear Commission Members:

Approximately one and one-half years ago the City of Alturas, a city of 3,000 people located in the State of California, filed a condemnation action against Pacific Power & Light, pursuant to which the City is attempting to take over Pacific's distribution facilities which serve the greater Alturas The City intends to have the facilities operated by Surprise Valley Electrification Corporation, an REA cooperative which surrounds Pacific's facilities and currently has approximately 4000 member/consumers.

Pacific has recently formally announced, through a pleading filed in the Federal District Court in Sacramento, the Court in which the condemnation action is pending, its intention to bring a Sherman Act antitrust action against the City. The purported basis for said action is that the combining of Pacific's facilities which are the subject of the condemnation action with those of Surprise Valley (which would together serve approximately 6000 members) constitutes "an attempt to monopolize and a conspiracy to monopolize the sale of electric power in Modoc County."

Surely, if a marger of two systems with combined consumers of approximately 6000 in number is an "attempt to monopolite" and "conspiracy to somopolize", than the proposed marger of Pacific Power & Light, resulting in a company that serves 1,000,000 consumers in seven states, must certainly likewise be in violation of the Shereon Act.
