**NOTICE OF INTERVENTION  
OF SALT LAKE COMMUNITY  
ACTION PROGRAM AND SALT  
LAKE CITIZENS CONGRESS**

Salt Lake Community Action Program and Salt Lake Citizens Congress hereby notify this Commission of their proposed intervention in this matter pursuant to Utah Admin. Code §R750-100-6(A)(1) and request that the 10 day notice period be waived. In support of this Notice, Salt Lake Community Action Program and Salt Lake Citizens Congress allege as follows:

1. Salt Lake Community Action Program and Salt Lake Citizens Congress represent low-income customers of Utah Power and Light in Salt Lake County and have frequently appeared before this Commission to represent their interests.

2. Salt Lake Community Action Program and Salt Lake Citizens Congress did not participate in the earlier hearing before this Commission in this case but appeared as intervenors

before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in their deliberations on this matter, Docket No. EC88-2-000.

3. Salt Lake Community Action Program and Salt Lake Citizens Congress believe that there may be a substantial adverse effect on low-income customers of Utah Power and Light as a result of FERC-imposed conditions arising from its Order of October 26, 1988.


4. Salt Lake Community Action Program and Salt Lake Citizens Congress desire the opportunity to clarify the potential increased costs or decreased benefits to low-income customers of Utah Power and Light by participating in this proceeding.

5. No other party to this proceeding represents low-income Utah Power and Light customers.

6. Intervention by Salt Lake Community Action Program and Salt Lake Citizens Congress would not seek to modify the record made earlier in this case but would clarify the effects of the FERC conditions on low-income Utah Power and Light customers.
