By the Commission:

On March 22, 1988, Amax Magnesium Corporation requested an extension of time to file its initial testimony in this case. It cited the extension in the FERC proceedings beyond FERC's original schedule as part of the basis for an extension in this case. Hearings Begin	May 2, 1988


