By the Commission:


By Commission Order issued February 26, 1988, the parties to the subject case, including Applicants, were ordered to respond by March 24, 1988 to the Utility Shareholders Association of Utah's "Proposed List of Facts Potentially to be Agreed Upon by the Parties and Facts in Dispute." Several parties, but by no means all, did so.


Applicant, Utah power & Light Company, on March 24, 1988, moved the Commission for an Order continuing the filing date for response to the Shareholders' proposed List of Facts from March 24, 1988, to close of business on April 11, 1988. In light of the fact that intervenor testimony will be filed with the Commission by close of business on April 6, 1988, and that such testimony will undoubtedly be enlightening in terms of contested issues of the case, the Commission hereby grants the Applicant's Motion in substance, but with modifications, by continuing the filing date from march 24, 1988 to April 15, 1988. The Issues

Conference to be convened by the Division of Public Utilities will be continued to April 21, 1988 and best efforts to reach agreement on agreed and disputed facts will be completed by April 29, 1988.

It is further ordered, that the Utility Shareholders Association of Utah and other parties who have previously filed responses to the proposed List of Stipulated Facts, file an amended statement or amended response reflecting positions taken in the testimony filed by intervenors.


