## ISSUED: March 9, 1988

By the Commission:

On March 3, 1988, Cedar City Corporation (Cedar City) filed a Motion for Review of Grouping. In support of its motion, Cedar City stated that its interests are divergent and unique from its grouping and are not adequately represented or protected through its group's representation. Specifically, Cedar City stated that its interest is divergent and unique because it is mandated by City Ordinance to pursue a municipal power system and that it is currently studying the feasibility of owning and operating its own system.

Cedar City further stated that its position is not one of opposition to the merger, but rather that the merger be conditioned upon the impact to power supplies and other related issues. Cedar City requested that the Commission consider grouping it with the group entitled "Wholesale Customers".

Also filed on March 3, 1988 was a Stipulation for Extension of Time and Order brought by Intervenors, Utah - 2 -

Independent Coal Companies, Utah Municipal Power Agency (UMPA) and Colorado River Energy Distributors Association (CREDA), and Applicant, Utah Power & Light Company. On March 7, 1988, Basic Manufacturing and Technologies of Utah, Inc. and Utah Power & Light Company filed a similar Stipulation. The parties agreed that the above-named intervenors may have up to and including March 14, 1988 to respond to Applicant's Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents dated February 22, 1988.

Based upon the foregoing and good cause appearing therefore, the Commission will make the following:

## <u>ORDER</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That the Intervenors' Independent Coal Companies, Utah Municipal Power Agency (UMPA), Colorado River Energy Distributors Association (CREDA), and Basic Manufacturing and Technologies, Inc. have up to and including March 14, 1988 in which to respond to Applicants' Interrogatories and Request for Production of Documents.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the Motion for Review of Grouping filed by Cedar City Corporation be and is hereby granted.
