MOTION FOR REVIEW OF GROUPING

CEDAR CITY CORPORATION, hereby submits the Motion for Review of Grouping in the above-captioned matter. In support of this Motion, CEDAR CITY CORPORATION states as follows:


1. Cedar City Corporation is an intervenor in the above-captioned matter.
2. Pursuant to an Order of Intervention issued by the Public Service Commission on October 30, 1987, Cedar City Corporation was grouped with larger retail municipal customers.
3. As this matter has progressed, it has become evident that the interests of Cedar City Corporation are divergent and unique from its grouping, and it is of the position that its interests are not adequately represented or protected through its group.

4. More specifically, Cedar City's interest is divergent and unique from its grouping for the reason that it is mandated by City Ordinance that the City pursue a municipal power system. Cedar City is studying the feasibility of owning and operating its own system.

5. The position of Cedar City is not one of opposition to the merger, but rather that the same be conditioned upon the impact to power supplies and other such related issues.

WHEREFORE, it is moved that the Commission review the grouping of intervenor Cedar City Corporation, and consider grouping Cedar City with the group entitled "Wholesale Customers" for the reason that Cedar City Corporation believes that its interests would thereby be adequately represented and protected.
