I am interested in the proposed merger of Utah Power & Light Co. with PacifiCorp. This is to voice my support for the approval of the action. I feel that the benefits of such a merger will derive to all of the users of electric power in the region served by Utah Power & Light Co.

Amoung the benefits as I understand them are these listed below:

- 1. Increased efficiency and a possible future reduction in the cost of electric power.
- 2. More stability in the rate structure.
