RE: *Proposals for DSR Cost Recovery*

Dear Doug:

On Monday, June 28, 1993, I received a copy of the minutes from the seventh DSR Technical Conference. Attached to the minutes are several proposals for rate-making treatment of DSR Investments.

The minutes also contain a schedule requiring parties who wish to include their positions in the final report to submit them to PacifiCorp by July 1, 1993 so that the comments can be distributed to all parties before the next meeting of the Technical Conference to be held on July 13, 1993.

The Utah industrial electric consumers ("UIEC") represented by this firm would like to have their comments included in the final paper to be submitted to the Public Service Commission. However, the UIEC find it impossible to comply with the short time period allowed for response.

As you know, the UIEC have objected to this collaborative due to the additional expense they must incur in order to participate, and due to the absence of the constitutional and statutory safeguards and guarantees of due process. Nevertheless, the UIEC have participated to the extent they have in an attempt to avoid being unfairly prejudiced in future proceedings before the Public Service Commission. It is, therefore, important to UIEC that the collaborative process not go forward without recognizing the UIEC's position.


