PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On January 6, 2000, Utah Power & Light Co. (UPL) filed a Request for Agency Action seeking approval for an amendment to the existing electric service agreement between itself and Geneva Steel Company (Geneva). The contract was originally with Geneva's predecessor in interest, Basic Manufacturing and Technologies. The matter was referred for review and recommendation to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), which filed its memorandum August 16, 2000, recommending approval. Additionally, the Utah Committee on Consumer Services, on August 16, 2000, filed a memorandum recommending approval. Since approval would appear to facilitate the continued operations of Geneva, to the benefit of the public through the collection of taxes and continued employment opportunities, the Commission enters the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- Amendment No. 6 to the existing electrical service agreement between PacifiCorp and Geneva Steel Company be, and it is, approved effective the date of this Order.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
