PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On June 25, 2001, Petitioner, Garkane Power Association, Inc., filed its Petition seeking a name change to GARKANE ENERGY COOPERATIVE, INC. The matter was referred for review and recommendation to the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce (DPU), which filed its memorandum recommending approval July 10, 2001. Since there appears to be no detriment to the public interest, and an evidentiary hearing on the matter would appear to be wholly superfluous, we have determined to dispose of the matter summarily. Accordingly we enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The proposed name change is approved and that the records of the Commission be amended to reflect the holder of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity issued to Garkane Power Association, Inc., be, and it is, changed to GARKANE ENERGY COOPERATIVE, INC.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
