ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

ISSUED: January 5, 2004

By The Commission:

On December 11, 2003, Utah Power & Light ("PacifiCorp") submitted a tariff filing regarding Schedule 113 - Cool Cash Incentive Program. The Division of Public Utilities was asked to investigate and report its recommendations by December 24, 2003. Prior to that date both the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") and the Committee of Consumer Services filed memoranda stating that additional time is needed by those agencies to complete their analyses, and requesting a two-week extension of the deadline. The Division memorandum also requested that the tariff be suspended until the Division is able to complete its analysis.

Based upon the memoranda filed herein, the Commission will suspend the tariff, and extend the deadline for responses to the proposed tariff by two weeks. The Commission will then consider all comments and responses submitted before addressing the merits of the tariff proposal and modifications thereto, if any.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the proposed PacifiCorp tariff filing is suspended pending further Order of the Commission.
