By The Commission:

On February 15, 2006, Utah Power & Light (“PacifiCorp”) submitted a tariff filing regarding proposed changes to Regulation 9 and to Schedule 300. The purpose of the proposed changes to Regulation 9 and Schedule 300 is to eliminate the \$150 ceiling on residential security deposits. Comments on the proposed tariff changes were filed March 14, 2006 by the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”). The Division recommends approval of the proposed changes to Regulation 9 and Schedule 300 contingent upon certain further language changes suggested by the Division and agreed to by PacifiCorp.

The Commission desires additional analysis of the problem to be solved by the proposed changes and of the propriety of the changes proposed. Therefore, the Commission suspends the tariff and will schedule future meetings to discuss the issues requiring further analysis.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The proposed PacifiCorp tariff filing is suspended pending further Order of the Commission.
