ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

ISSUED: September 21, 2006

By The Commission:

On August 15, 2006, PacifiCorp d/b/a Rocky Mountain Power (“Petitioner”) submitted Advice No. 06-09 regarding a proposed new Electric Service Schedule No. 111 offering a comprehensive energy efficiency program to its residential customers. According to the Advice, this program, called the Home Energy Savings Incentive Program (“Program”), will provide a broad platform for delivery of energy efficiency incentives and is designed to provide energy efficiency participation opportunities to virtually all residential customers with a new or existing home, multi-family unit or manufactured home. Petitioner has requested an effective date of September 14, 2006, for this new tariff.

The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) was asked to investigate and filed a memorandum on September 7, 2006, recommending the Commission suspend this tariff filing pending various suggested changes to the tariff. The Division also recommends the Commission order the Company to provide the reason for its proposed changes and demonstrate that those changes, at a minimum, maintain the Program’s cost-effectiveness.

Based upon the pleadings filed herein, the Commission will suspend the tariff filing pending further investigation of the proposed tariff.

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ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the proposed Pacificorp d/b/a Rocky Mountain Power tariff filing be and it is suspended pending further Order of the Commission.
