By the Commission:

Based on the information presented by complainant, Ted Reynolds, and Barbara Coughlin of Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) at the telephonic conference held October 23, 2008 with the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), Ruben Arredondo, the Commission makes the following order regarding scheduling in this docket.

RMP has represented that the tree-trimming process has already begun. RMP represented to the ALJ that the tree-trimming work was currently in the bidding process. RMP represented that it hoped to have the actual tree-trimming commence about November 11, 2008 and have the work completed about mid-December, absent RMP having to pull work crews off for any emergencies. Therefore, the Commission orders as follows:

<b>RMP commences tree-trimming on or before:</b>	Tuesday, November 18, 2008
<b>Telephonic conference regarding status of commencement of tree-trimming; discussion of nature and scope of work to be completed:</b>	Tuesday, November 18, 2008, 9:30 a.m.
<b>Anticipated complete date for tree-trimming:</b>	Thursday, December 18, 2008
<b>Telephonic conference regarding status of completion of tree-trimming; if needed, discussion of additional measure needed:</b>	Thursday, December 18, 2008, 9:30 a.m.

Additionally, RMP shall provide Mr. Reynolds with the mailing address and office fax number for RMP CEO, no later than November 18, 2008.

Individuals wishing to participate by telephone at the hearing should contact the Commission at least two days prior, so as to make arrangements. On the day of the hearing, participants must call (801) 530-6716 or call toll-free 1-866 PSC-UTAH (866-772-8824) at least five minutes prior to the hearing to ensure participation. *In the alternative, RMP may arrange a telephone meeting as it previously did for the October 23, 2008 hearing.*
