By The Commission:

On January 10, 2003, Light and Truth petitioned for leave to intervene in this docket and PSC Docket No. 99-057-20. Light and Truth stated it sought intervention to participate in matters dealing with Questar Gas Company's Low-Income Weatherization Program. The weatherization program was undertaken through the order issued in Docket No. 99-057-20 to encourage conservation of resources. In that docket, by letter dated March 2, 2001, the Commission directed that, as of that date, all issues associated with the weatherization program would be dealt with in PSC Docket No. 01-057-04. Since the given basis for Light and Truth's desire to intervene is no longer part of this docket, the Petition for Leave to Intervene is denied.

The Commission notes that it intends Docket No. 01-057-04 to be an informal proceeding. Intervention in that docket is not needed for Light and Truth to participate. Indeed, as an informal proceeding, no provision for intervention is contemplated by Utah law. Light and Truth should be able to participate in any proceedings, meetings, etc. undertaken in Docket No. 01-057-04 dealing with the weatherization program. Other participants should include Light and Truth in their
