**RE: Supplemental Information and Correction to the Surebuttal Testimony of Sarah Wright on behalf of Utah Clean Energy (UCE) for Docket No. 05-057-T01 *In the Matter of the Joint Application of Questar Gas Company, the Division of Public Utilities, and Utah Clean Energy for the Approval of the Conservation Enabling Tariff Adjustment Option and Accounting Orders*, submitted August 31, 2007**

Dear Commissioners:

On September 18<sup>th</sup>, during the hearing on Docket 05-057-T01, Chairman Boyer asked me about the 2007 American Council for an Energy-Efficient Economy (ACEEE) study on the savings attributable to educational programs. I have reread the ACEEE study referenced on lines 113-115 of my Surebuttal Testimony. The study's use of a three percent energy savings that I referred to was assumed based on the results of short-term public awareness and media campaigns in California and New York.

Therefore, my testimony should be changed by deleting "and California" and by replacing the word "showed" with "assumed" on line 114. And for clarification, please add the following clarifying statement immediately following reference seven on line 115:

"The energy savings assumption is based on ACEEE's review of the experiences of California and New York in achieving energy savings through short-term public education and awareness efforts."
